A Legacy of Transforming Lives

Professor M. S. Swaminathan, a luminary in sustainable agriculture and food security, is celebrated as the architect of India's Green Revolution. His peerless contributions were recognized in 2024 when he was posthumously awarded the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honour, highlighting his lifelong mission to eliminate hunger and promote rural prosperity through science and technology. His global recognition includes roles such as the Chairman of the UN Science Advisory Committee, Independent Chairman of the FAO Council (1981–85), and President of the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN, 1984–90). He led India's agricultural transformation as Director General of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and later as Director General of the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI), where his innovative strategies became a global template for agricultural advancement

TIME magazine listed him as one of the 20 most influential Asians of the 20th century, alongside Mahatma Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore. Known as the "Father of Economic Ecology" by the United Nations Environment Programme, Professor Swaminathan's leadership in the

ever-green revolution introduced sustainable practices in agriculture, addressing food security without compromising environmental health

In recognition of his extraordinary contributions to agriculture and food security, he was honoured with numerous prestigious awards, including the Padma Shri (1967), Ramon Magsaysay Award (1971), Padma Bhushan (1972), World Food Prize (1987), Padma Vibhushan (1989), and Indira Gandhi Prize for Peace, Disarmament, and Development (2000).

In an era marked by existential challenges -- climate change, energy crises, and deepening inequalities -- Dr. Swaminathan's legacy stands as a beacon of hope and inspiration. His life's work underscores the urgency of transforming global systems through the fusion of scientific innovation and social justice. Celebrating his centenary is not merely a tribute to his monumental achievements but a call to action, reaffirming a global commitment to sustainable agriculture, food security, and a hungerfree world. His vision of cooperation and benevolence among individuals, institutions, and nations continues to guide us in addressing the complex challenges of our time
